

# Participants Needed Assistive Robots for ALS

Join our research study to test a new robot with an arm and a mobile base in your home, lab, or anywhere!

## Who is eligible?

- Age 18 or older, diagnosed with ALS
- Difficulty using arms/hands for daily tasks
- Can communicate in English (speaking or AAC)
- Can use a computer or tablet (with or without assistive technology)
- For remote: have internet and a device to access the robot



## What is involved?

- Complete a demographics and upper limb function questionnaire
- Join a session with our research team (no more than 2.5 hours) either onsite at our lab or remotely from a location of your choice
  - Learn how to control the robot using a web-based interface
  - Use the robot to complete simple, everyday tasks
  - Have your interactions with the robot observed and recorded to help us understand how it supports users
  - Share your feedback in a brief final interview
- Receive \$125 for your participation
  - *(Optional) If a care partner joins the interview, they will receive \$30. Care partner participation is not required.*
